"How President Roosevelt and Generalissimo Chiang worked together to win the war against Japan".

中美合作:羅斯福統總與蔣委員長如何共同領導贏得抗日戰爭勝利

General Tang Gang-Xi joined the Central Military Academy in the late 1930s to fulfill the "100,000 youth 100,000 soldiers" movement. After graduating in the 19th class, he was assigned to the Artillery Troop, and engaged in anti-Japan invasion war in Yun-Nan Province. He became an Army military attaché for Chinese Embassy at Tokyo after WWII. Later he served as a liaison officer for the Republic of China in Taiwan to hire former Japanese officers as military trainers and advisor known as "Baibing-tuan" (White Military Advisor Group). Therefore, he studied Sino-Japanese relationship for a long time and is able to provide his thoughts about WWII from a close and personal perspective.
