ONE DAY EVENT: HAOQI LONG EPIC 浩氣長流 - This amazing scroll was first unveiled on July 6, 2010 in Chongqing 重慶, China and a smaller vinyl replica is touring the U.S. with a one day stop in San Diego. Fifty artists and volunteers worked for eight years to make China's cultural folk scholar Wang Kang's vision of creating a monument for fallen heroes of the Anti-Japanese War and WWII come true. The 1,012 meter scroll depicts 1,400 military martyrs, Chinese and foreign political figures, and civil and common people during the Anti-Japanese War and WWII.

GUEST LECTURER: WANG KANG 王康 - Well known Chinese thinker, philosopher, and organizer of the "Haoqi Long Epic" scroll will discuss the creation of this massive art piece.
