Ms. Betty Chu, born and raised in San Diego, obtained bachelor of Science (Business Administration), University of Southern California and Juris Doctor, University of Southern California. She served two-term Councilmember & Mayor of the City of Monterey Park elected in 2003 and reelected in 2009. She was the First female Founding Chairman and CEO of a Savings and Loan in the nation, first female Chinese lawyer in Southern California and founder of the first Chinese owned Savings and Loan in the nation. In addition, she was Attorney, California State Bar member Private general law practice, Deputy Corporation Commissioner, and served as many county counsels in Los Angeles county.
