Bio of Dr. Joseph Y.K. Wong:

Dr. Joseph Wong, with degrees of C.M., M.D., D.Sc., chair of ALPHA Education, founded Toronto ALPHA in 1997 with the mandate to seek justice for the victims and foster humanity and started education ALPHA Education in 2004. He began his family practice in Toronto in 1982, taught hospitals from 1976 to 1981. He was named Toronto Star Man of the Year in 1986. He received many awards including the Canadian Red Cross Humanitarian Award in 2005

Bio of Ms. Flora Chong:

Ms. Flora Chong, with a Bachelor degree in Business and Information Systems, and a Master degree in Social Justice and Education, is the Executive Director and Vice Chair of ALPHA Education. She has helped spearheading many educational and public awareness programs on the history of Asia-Pacific War within Canada and beyond, including presentations at high schools, universities, student and teacher conferences, and various international conferences, representing Toronto ALPHA. She received the Queen Elizabeth II's Golden Jubilee Medal in 2002 and Queen Elizabeth II's Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2012.
