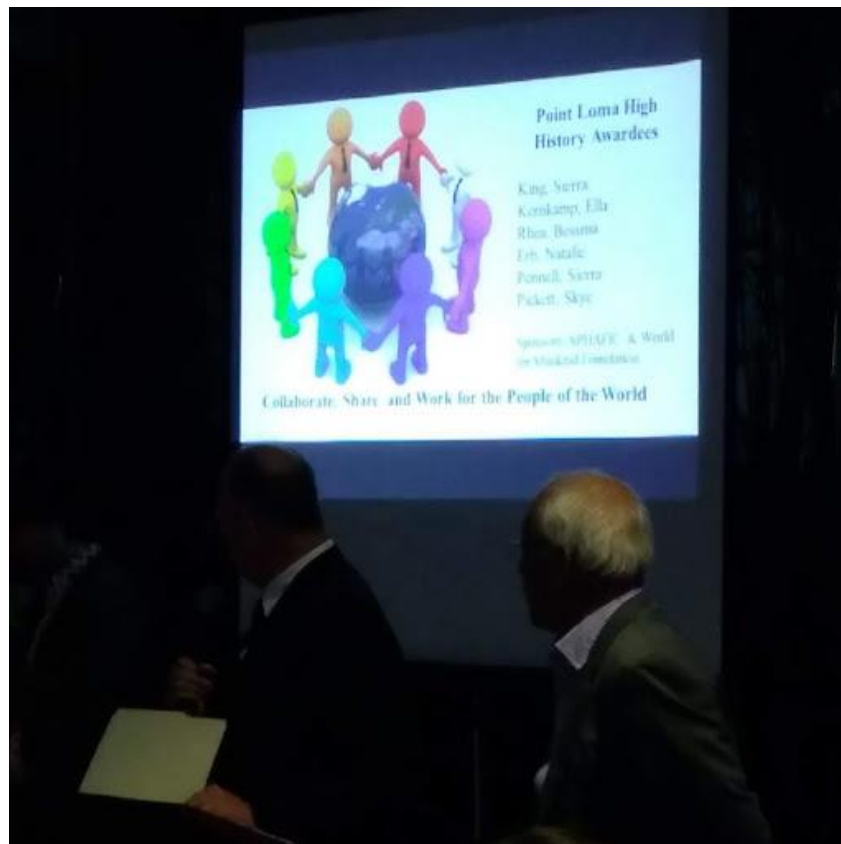


Point Loma History Awards Banquet on May 30, 2019
